Course Description

This is a 4-hour virtual reality scenario-based training. Using the MILO Range System Simulator, each member of the class will participate in a variety of scenarios emphasizing proper use of force, de-escalation techniques, and decision making in many common police calls for service. Officers will need to bring their duty belt and holster and typical duty gear.

Course Objectives

Demonstrate and discuss proper level of force for each of the following levels of resistance per Federal and State Law related to the simulator scenarios.

- Cooperative person
- Passive resister
- Active resister
- Aggressive assailant
- Deadly force assailant

An opportunity to debrief and discuss the officer's response to the scenarios will be provided to build up officers practical knowledge on the topic.
